

FAQs

Who can participate?	Anyone can participate as long as they are above 18 years of age and carry a valid Govt. of India ID along. We believe in mutual inclusion! :)
What do I need to bring to the event?	Besides motivation and passion to intertwine social impact and technology, participants should bring valid Govt. of India ID so we can verify and register you on-site! and Please bring your own Laptop to work on along with a charger & whatever software you feel might be necessary for development Bring your cell phone and charger too, and a power splitter if you have one!
Is this a team event?	Yes, please limit your team to no more than five people. Seriously, any more and you'd need a SCRUM master to coordinate your hacking!
How much does it cost?	Registration is free! Food, drinks, swag, and plenty of coffee is all on the house.
Will there be food?	Yes. The only thing you need to worry about is coding; let us take care of the rest. Breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, and plenty of drinks will be provided throughout the competition at no cost to participants.
How big can my team be?	Teams can comprise of a minimum of 2 to a maximum of 5 people.
Can I work on my previous projects?	No, all projects must start from scratch and built during the time you are at the event. Ideas may be generated beforehand.
Can I be reimbursed for travel expenses if I don't live in the area?	Unfortunately, we are not able to provide reimbursements for travel or accommodation at the moment. Please look towards future editions of the event as this may become available.
What if I'm new?	3Pillar Hack Fest has great opportunities for people that are new to programming. In fact, we encourage new programmers to come because hackathons provide an opportunity to gain experience. As a new programmer at 3Pillar Hack Fest, you will learn a lot in a short amount of time, be challenged, and build something awesome.
What if it's my first hackathon?	No worries! 3Pillar Hack Fest is beginner friendly, so no experience necessary! There will be plenty of mentors on hand to help you bring your wildest dreams into creation!
How does judging work?	Teams will demo their application to a panel of judges, who will deliberate on their favorite submissions to choose the winners.
Are we allowed to build on past projects?	This experience is meant to build on something completely new. With that in mind, you cannot work on past projects. Using your own APIs or third-party APIs is alright as long as the project is a fresh start. You can't demo something you didn't build.
